

EXAMPLES OF LEGISLATION THAT WILL / WILL NOT BE  
AFFECTED BY WITHDRAWAL FROM THE EU

<b>COMPETITION LAW</b>	
<b>EU legislation that will cease to apply</b>	<b>UK legislation that will be unaffected</b>
Articles 101 and 102 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (“TFEU”), which set out rules relating to anti-competitive agreements and abuses of market power in the EU.	The Competition Act 1998 (Chapter I and Chapter II prohibitions), which set out rules relating to anti-competitive agreements and abuses of market power in the UK. The Chapter I and Chapter II prohibitions mirror Articles 101 and 102 of TFEU.
EU procurement rules relating to the purchase of goods, works or services by public sector bodies.	EU procurement rules have been implemented into UK law by various regulations, including the Public Contracts Regulations 2015.
All of State aid law, including articles 107 and 108 of TFEU and all State aid related Regulations, including the General Block Exemption Regulation.
