EU legislation that will cease to apply	UK legislation that will be unaffected
	<p>The vast majority of property laws in the UK are national laws and will, therefore, be unaffected by Brexit. For example:</p> <p>The Law of Property Act 1925</p> <p>The Landlord and Tenant Act 1954.</p>
	<p>Other UK property legislation implements into national law EU Directives. For example:</p> <p>The Energy Act 2011, which implements the provisions of the Energy Performance of Buildings Directive.</p> <p>The Heat Network (Metering and Billing) Regulations 2014, which implement the provisions of the Energy Efficiency Directive.</p>
